Staff and Course Changes

In keeping with Social Distancing protocols GVS will not be able to offer any in-school band courses for the second semester. Mr. Neufeld will work with those students virtually on their off Track days.

Due to a shortage in Specialist teachers GVS will not be able to offer any grades 9-12 French classes.

Starting January 18, 2021, Mrs. Marie Schriemer will no longer be a part of the GVS teaching staff, she has been reassigned to HSD to be a Remote Learning teacher. We want to thank her for her dedication to our students' education and wish her the best in this new assignment.

GVS is Moving Back to Restricted Level Orange

GVS will be returning to the Restricted Level (Orange) in Manitoba's Pandemic Response System. We will not be opening up any extra-curricular activities until the entire province is out of the RED Level and until Manitoba Health deems it safe to slowly and safely reopen other recreational activities and facilities. Please note that the plans shared here may be subject to change as schools in the entire province get further guidance and direction from Manitoba Public Health and Manitoba Education.

Beginning January 18, GVS will fully move back to the Restricted (Orange) Level. Students in grades 9-12 will return to their in-school learning on their assigned track days. Friday classes will continue to be remote for our high school students. TRACK A students will attend on January 18 and TRACK B students will attend on January 19.

On January 18 our grade 7-8 students will also resume their in-school learning on their assigned track days as well. TRACK C students will attend on the 18th and TRACK D students will attend on the 19th. See below calendar for January's Track Calendar:

Reminders for Students Returning to In-School Learning

- Students are reminded to enter GVS at their designated entrances.
